Registration on Tournament Day:

Upon arriving at Park Ridge Country Club, we ask that you please register in the Pro Shop. You will receive a tournament credential that will entitle you to a complimentary continental breakfast, fruit and drink on the course, and a BBQ lunch in our dining room. We are encouraging contestants to stay until the tournament is completed and enjoy the festivities.

Locker Room:

You will have full use of our locker room.

Tee-Off times:

Tee times will begin at 8:00 a.m. with 10-minute intervals. Contestants will be paired in threesomes. *Check the Park Ridge Country Club Website for pairings [Go to: www.parkridgecc.org. Select “Menu” from the top left and then “Champion of Champions” and then “2023 Event”.*

Tee times will be posted no later than Sunday September 24. Tee times may change slightly through Wednesday, September 27. If the change affects you, we will contact you by phone or email. Please note that if you arrive late for the assigned tee time, the penalty is disqualification.

Each threesome will have a Park Ridge Country Club host/hostess. They will have immediate access to tournament officials.
